Easily to Transact of Business of the said Free school
IN THE year of our Lord God one thousand six
hundred ninety and Six the Honourable Francis Nicholson Esq^r
His then Majesty Captain Generall and Governour in Chief
in and over this province, Excited by a laudable Zeale and pious
Inclination of promoting a Free school within the towne and port
of Annapolis and being possessor of three Lotts of Land in the said
towne lying to the foot of the said new Hill on y^e East ward thereof
