

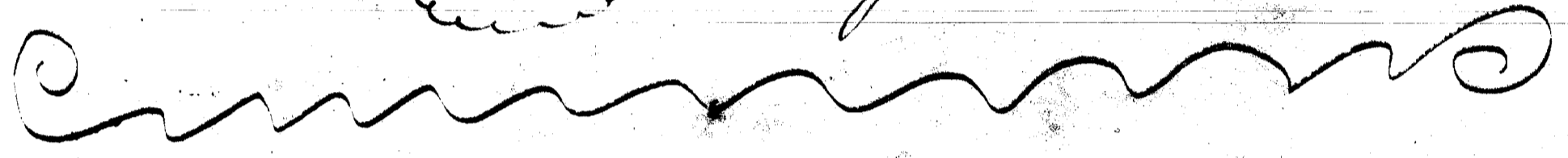

An Act to supply Certain Defects in the Conveying  
of Land from Matthew Beard to Stephen Wright  
and from Stephen Wright to Samuel Chambers of  
Annamundell County Gent.

Whereas Matthew Beard late of Annamundell County in the province  
of Maryland Carpenter by his Deed of bargain & Sale bearing date the  
Twelfth day of November Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred  
and eight for the Consideration of twenty five pounds Sterling  
granted and sold unto Stephen Wright of the same County  
and province planter and to his heirs and assigns forever  
the moiety or half parts of a tract or parcel of land called  
Timborneck Lying in Annamundell County on the South Side  
of South River on the side of a Creek called Jacobs Creek  
Beginning at a marked red oak standing upon a point and  
running for breadth West South west up the Creek One hundred  
and sixty perches to a marked Oak by a Marsh side being bounded  
tree of Richard Beards on the west by Beards line drawn west and north  
two hundred perches to a marked rock hickory and by a line drawn  
north and by East from the said rock hickory fifty perches to a marked  
red oak in the line of Richard Choups land and by Choups line east  
south East twenty five perches to a marked white oak bounded on
