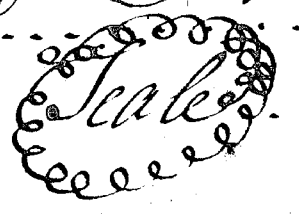

Be it hereby Enacted and declared by the Authority aforesaid that all such Duties as have been received or secured by or to the use of the Impost and since his said late Lord's decess shall be accounted for in manner as and applyed to the use of any Discontinuance of the said Duty by the decess of the said Lord Baltimore or otherwise to the contrary notwithstanding

An Act Relating to the Standard of English Weights and measures

Whereas the Standards of English weights and measures are very much Impaired in severall of the Countys of this Province and in some wholly lost or unfit for use

Be it Enacted by the Kings most Excellent Majesty by and with the Advice and Consent of his Majesties Governour Council and Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same that the Justices of the severall Countys Courts shall by all convenient speed at the Charge of their respective Countys Cause the Standards they already have to be made Compleat and purchased new standards where they have none and for the Better preservation of them for the future that they Take good and sufficient Security in his Majestys name to the use of the County where taken from the persons that shall be Intrusted
