 Whereas this present General Assembly have for the defraying
 the publick Charges of this Province to the twenty Eight day of
 may one thousand seven hundred and fifteen raised a certain
 sume of Tobacco and money amounting to the sume of three ^{hundred} ~~six~~
 Eight thousand two hundred and Sixty pounds of Tobacco and one
 hundred ninety six pounds Nine shillings and four pence say
 penny Currant money but by reason more Publick Charges
 may arise and grow due before the usual and accustomed time
 of payment which is the tenth day of October yearly at
 which Time againe to Call and Convene the whole Assembly for
 that Occasion only Considering the great number of them
 and their moteness of their habitations from the place appointed
 would be very Chargeable and Troublesome to the whole Province
 in General for prevention whereof Be it Enacted by the
