An Act for taking Speciale Bayle in the  
Several Countys of this Province upon actions or suits  
depending in the Majestys provinciall Court and in the  
Several County Courts of this Province for the better  
for the greater ease and Benefit of all persons inhabiting or residing  
Within this Province in having recognizance of payment made before hand  
of such depending or to be depending in his Majestys several County Courts  
of this Province! Be it Enacted by the King in Exercice  
Majestys by and with the advice and Consent of the Upper House  
Councell and Assembly of this Province and the Subsidy of same  
that it Shall and may be lawfull to and for the defendant in any  
writ Issued or to be issued out of the forenamed Court after Plaintiff Bayle  
given to the Sheriff for his Appearance and before the returne of  
such writs to go before one of the Justices of the procell Court or  
before the President or any two Justices of the County Court where  
such Defendant shall be arrested with two sufficient freeholders  
of this province such as the Justice or Justices before whom such  
Defendant Shall be shall approve of and then and there give Speciale  
Bayle to any action wherein he shall be so arrested by virtue  
of such writs which bayle so taken shall be delivered to the Sheriff  
of such County where the same is taken to be kept in returned with  
such writ to the provinciall Court

And Be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid by and  
with the advice and Consent aforesaid that when Speciale Bayle is  
required in the provinciall Court by the Plaintiffis Attorney at the  
Calling over the appearance Regett and that the Court doth rule  
Speciale Bayle shall be given and the party against whom the rule is  
given that he shall give Speciale Bayle before the party Defendant  
Shall then and there give Speciale Bayle in open Court and shall be  
deemed to be in the Custody of the Sheriff that arrested him
