

Likewise approved by the Justices of the County of
Bucks in which he is to range as a Deputy. —

And so much as it is necessary to declare what
a horseman and Cattle shall be deemed with.

Be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid with the
advice and Consent aforesaid that it shall not be lawful for any
ranger within this Prince to take up and mark or otherwise
disposse of any unmarked horse mare bull or Cow which
shall not exceed the age of three years under penalty of suffering
as any other person ought that hath not such Consciencie
and usage or Custom to the contrary notwithstanding —
And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid
with the advice and Consent aforesaid that the Justices in each
Respective County within this Prince shall yearly and
every year at their County Courts in the Monthes of Nov
ember and March during the continuall of this act
cause it to be read in every Court and likewise give it in
Chare to the grand Juries to enquire of any Broaches
thereof committed by wood rangers in that County
And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid
and with the advice and Consent aforesaid that no person
whatsoever shall presume to range in the woods or Forrests
after wild heath Cattle or horses without a Licence from
his Excellency the governour in Chiefe for the time being
under the penality of five thousand pound of tobacco per
Every such before mentioned wild creature that every such
unlicenced Ranger shall kill take or convey away alive
or dead one hundred Majesties his heirs and successors for the
support of Government of this province the other halfe to the
Informer or him or them that shall sue for the same by action
of Debt bill plaint or Information in any Court of record in this
Prince wherein no Especial protection or wager of Law to be allowed
And Be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid that
if any Ranger or his deputy shall presume to range take up or kill any
wild heath Cattle for poor Mare many Island or Islands pasture or
other Inclosed groundes belonging to any of the Inhabitants of this
Province without the leave of the owner of the same shall for feit
for Every beast so taken up or killed as of the sume of five thousand
(pounds)
