tenor of the said ^{Deed} and that the want of an opportunity of
getting the same acknowledged before two Justices was the
only Cause of the said Thomas Larkyn Delaying to get the said
Deed Recorded in expectation of getting the said William Junr to
acknowledge same anew in his Lifetime but for that the said
William Junr is now dead it is fulmly prayed that it may
be Enacted And be it Enacted by the King most
