his Heirs and Successors for the Support of the Government of this
Prince and the Person that shall be Summoned as Evidences and shall
make default as aforesaid shall not only be liable to the fines aforesaid but
shall also beduly to answer the party for whom he shall be Summoned
in action upon the Cause for the damage sustained for want of his
appearance to testifie according to such Summons and shall be held
to Speciall Bayle on such action and shall be liable to a Conviction
thereon for all damage that shall be sustained by such party provided
such Evidence shall be called & called & called at the request of the party for whom such
Evidence shall have been Summoned to have his Person or their Body or
bodies attached by Proces out of the Court to which they were Summoned
which such Court is hereby authorized and required to award accordingly
by virtue of which proces the Sheriff shall be obliged to have
the Body of such Evidence at the Court where such Writ shall be
returned to and shall Oblige their attendance at y^e same Court and in
Case any witness summoned or attached who being present shall
refuse or delay to give his Evidence such Witness shall be Committed
to Gaol there to remaine till he shall willingly do the same
and for the Ascertaining the Expences of Jurors and Evidences
Be it Enacted that it shall and may be Lawfull for his
Majesties Justices of the provinciall Court of this Prince to allow
unto the grand Jurors that shall serve in y^e provinciall Court
towards the defraying the Expences of the said Jurors for every Court they
shall attend and Quantity of lob^v not exceeding three thousand pounds
of lob^v at the discretion of such Justices to be paid out of the publick
Treasury of this Prince And be it also Enacted that it shall and
may be Lawfull for the Justices of the several and respective County Courts
of this Prince to allow unto grand Jurors that shall serve in the
several and respective County Courts any sume of lob^v at the
Discretion
