

Administrator shall then be Comitted to such other proper person as the Judge for probat of Wills & granting Administrations shall legally approve of Durante minority to the profit use & behoofe of the Infant &c. or (not) & not otherwise nor in any other manner - And forasmuch as the right to adm<sup>n</sup> of the goods of persons Intestate may fall upon persons under the age of seven teen years it is hereby declared that as they are within the reason so they are within like law with Infant &c. - Sixth that every female Orphan shall be accounted of full age to receive her Estate at the age of sixteen years or day of Marriage w<sup>h</sup> shall first happen - Seventh that all Negroes & other Slaves after the transmitting the Estate to the County Courts as afores<sup>d</sup> shall be appraised to the Guardian or Trustees & preserved by them & be employed to the s<sup>d</sup> Guardian or Trustees use & benefit & the like number of Slaves & of the like Ability of Body be returned to the s<sup>d</sup> Orphans out of their increase or otherwise at their full age by this Law limited & if any of the said Slaves be grown aged or otherwise impotent or be lamed & that the Increase will not make the Originall Stock good as to the Number & ability of Body that then they shall be again appraised by the said County Courts & the Guardian & Trustees shall pay to the Orphans so much money or Tobacco as the County Court shall adudge the Orphans Stock of Negroes then to be of less Value then they were at the time of their first appraisement & delivery of their said Slaves to the said Guardian & Trustees but in Case no Guardian or other person will upon those termes accept of those Slaves then it shall & may be lawfull for the s<sup>d</sup> s<sup>d</sup>all & respective County Courts to put the said Slaves out upon other termes to any other person so that the said originall Stock of Slaves be not sold nor any of their Increase but in the best Manner preferred for the Orphans till they come to their s<sup>d</sup>all - Ages by this Act limited & appointed to the Intent they may have their first stock made good to them in Number Value & ability of Body if it may be - Eighth that all servants for years be likewise returned in kind to the Orphans at their full age (that is to say the same Number of the same age & sex & by like Number of years to serve & of the same ability of Body as near as Can be Estimated as the servants were when receed by the Guardian or Trustee - And to the End that after an acc<sup>t</sup> or distribution made as afores<sup>d</sup> the ballance of such acc<sup>t</sup> or the distribution of such Ballance may not be neglected to be transmitted to the s<sup>d</sup>all & respective Justice of the County Courts as before is directed - All it Enacted by the Kings most excellent Majesty by & with the advice & Consent afores<sup>d</sup> that if such Judge for probat of Wills Comissary or Comissarys Generall shall not within three Months after such account made up Exhibited & paid in his Office or after distribution made by him as afores<sup>d</sup> transmit the ballance or acct thereof as before by this Act is directed to the s<sup>d</sup>all & respective Justices of the County Courts where the Estate shall bee & remaine he or they shall forfeit & pay to our Sovereign Lord the King his heirs & successors the sume of ten thousand pounds of Tobacco of which one moiety for the support of Govern<sup>t</sup> of this
