(21) Provides the other Moyerly to him or them that shall sue for the same
to be recovered by action of Debt bill plaint or Information wherein
no Essoyn protection or Wager of Law to be allowed — *Item 6th* —
Whereas every Administrator in an Inventory incerts what debts are
desperate & what debts are desperate the Judge for probate of Will shall
transmit those desperate debts of the Estate unto the Sheriff and
respective Justices of the County Court where the Estate shall lie —
to the end the said Justices may enquire whether the Estate hath by
fraud or otherwise neglected to recover the same or hath recd and
never accounted for the same & shall with the residue of the said
Estate sum it the said desperate debts to the Care of the Guardian
or other Trustee by them employed & shall yearly & every year
call the said Guardians to acct for the same & duly inspect what
of the said debts they have recd or might have received & if the
Guardian or Trustee fails to give in his acct yearly or by fraud or
neglect or forbear to recover the same the said Guardian or
Trustee shall stand & be accountable for every such debts by him
recd & not accounted for or neglected or foreborn to be recovered
under the penalty of five hundred pounds of Tobacco each Justice
present in Court one halfe to his Master the other halfe to the Informer
or him or them that shall sue for the same to be recovered as aforesd

Seventh that the Justices of the County Courts take able & sufficient
Security for Orphans Estates & enquir yearly of the security & if there
be just cause that they require new & better security & upon refusal to
give new & better security that they remove the Orphans Estates out
of their hands & farther that the Justices of the County Courts shall
yearly in June Court enquir by a Jury of good & lawfull men to be
summoned out of the several hundred of the County not under the
Number of twelve who upon their oaths shall enquire according to
the forme hereafter express — viz whether the Orphans be kept main-
tained & educated according to their Estates and Whether apprentices
are taught their trade or ingourably used & turned to common labours
at the Axe or Hoe instead of learning their trades p if they find
that Orphans are not Maintained & educated according to their
Estates or apprentices neglected to be taught their trades upon
prefrence that the last year is enough to learn their trade that they
remove them to other Guardians or Masters and in Case the Jury find
that any apprentice is not taught his trade but put to other labour
as aforesd the County Court shall condemn the Master of such apprentice
to make the apprentice such satisfaction as in Justice his years of
Labour or other Worke shall deserve — *Eighth* that the Justices
of the County Courts cause the Condition of the bonds they take from
Guardians or Trustees of Orphans Estate to be exactly drawn according
to this Act to be recorded in the County Court to the Indentures for apprentices
