

likewise that it may duly appear to the Justice whether Guardians  
 Trustees & Masters do right & Justice to Apprentices to the Country  
 & that the Justice do right between them & to that end that they  
 Cause the Clerke of their County to present the Jury with a list of the  
 Orphan & Apprentices of their County every June Court. Item the  
 And for better ascertaining what salary shall be allowed Executors  
 & Admrs upon their account of Administration by the Comissary Genall  
 of this Province for their pains & trouble heaped & adventured in  
 Administering Estates - Be it enacted by the Authority aforesd  
 by & with the advice & Consent aforesd that for every sum or sums  
 of Money quantity or quantity of Tobacco or other good or Chattell  
 that shall be bona fide paid by Executors or Admrs to the Comissary Genall  
 shall allow the Executors or Admrs the salary of ten per Cent except as  
 is herein after Excepted - And be it further enacted by the  
 Authority aforesd by & with the advice & Consent aforesd that if  
 the residuary Legatees of any person or persons dying within this Province  
 & making a Will or the next of kindred to any person or persons dying  
 Intestate in this Province & who ought to have the residue of such  
 deceased persons Estate do dwell in England or other parts of his Majesty  
 Dominions out of this Province so that the Executors or Admrs convert  
 the residue of all the real & personall Estate (after debts & legacies here  
 paid) into money or other effects for the best advantage of the person  
 to whom due & returns the same to such Residuary Legatees or kindred  
 as aforesd that then the Comissary Genall shall allow to such Executors or  
 Admrs the usuall salary allowed by Merchants to their factors Vizt ten  
 per Cent. - And whereas it some time happens that persons of great  
 dealing dying in this Province have their books very imperfect so that  
 it cannot be exactly known what debts are due upon such books unless  
 the Executors or Admrs takes the pains to Carry about such books from one  
 supposed debtor to another to state the accounts wth many times proving  
 considerable toyle to the Executor or Admrs & requires a very great  
 trouble & Charge & many times there appear discounts or defeasances  
 or receipts to bar such books debts or the debtors where the accounts  
 are old are Insolvent or the like & the Executors or Admrs for such their  
 great pains & diligence have hitherto had no allowance. Therefore  
 least it should be a discouragement to Executors or Admrs that having no  
 salary therefore they should be negligent or too sparing of pains  
 to improve the Testators or others Estates - Be it enacted by the  
 Authority advice & Consent aforesd that where the Executors or Admrs can  
 fairly make appear to the Comissary Genall that he hath had such  
 considerable toyle as aforesd & no benefit hath arisen to him thereby  
 to recompence his sd. toyle it may be lawfull to & for the said Comissary  
 Genall to allow such Executors or Admrs some thing in the whole for such
