

91. Register or Justice of the County where such runaway is apprehended  
 who is hereby empowered to take into Custody or otherwise secure him or  
 them to Secure and Dispose of as he shall think fit until such person  
 or persons so seized and apprehended shall give good and sufficient security  
 to Answer the promises the next Court that shall sit in the said  
 County which Court shall secure such person or persons till he or they  
 can make Satisfaction to the party that shall apprehend or seize  
 Such runaways or other persons as by this act is required except such  
 person shall make Satisfaction as aforesaid before such Court shall  
 happen and that notice may be conveniently given to the master  
 or mistress Dame or overseer of runaways taken up and the Commis-  
 sioners of the County shall forthwith cause a Notice of the runaways  
 name so seized and apprehended as aforesayd to be set up at the next  
 adjacent County Courts and at the provincial Court and Secretarys  
 office that all persons may view the same and see where such their  
 Servants are and in whose Custody -

And furthermore for ascertaining what each Servant  
 according to the Custom of the County shall have at the Expir-  
 ation of his Servitude - Be it Enacted By the authority aforesaid  
 Consent aforesayd that every man Servant shall get such value of  
 Expiration of his Servitude as aforesayd have given him one new hat  
 a good Suit (that is to say) Coat and Breeches either of Kersey or  
 Broad Cloth one new Shift of white Linen one new pair of French  
 Satin Shooes and Stockins two Hoes and one ax and one Gun of twenty  
 Shillings price not above four foot by the barrel nor Less than three  
 and a half which said Gun shall by the master or Mistress in the  
 presence of the next Justice of the peace be delivered to such Freeman  
 under the penalty of five hundred pounds of Tobacco on such master  
 or Mistress omitting or lo do and the like penalty on the said  
 Freeman selling or disposing thereof within the space of twelve  
 months the one half whereof to our Sovereign Lord the King his  
 heirs and Successors the other to the Informer, all women ser-  
 vant at the Expiration of their Servitude as aforesayd shall have allowed and  
 given a Coat and Petticoat of such thickness or Penitence as  
 one Shift of white Linen Shooes and Stockins a Breeches one  
 Cap of white Linen and three barrels of Indian Cure -

And be it further Enacted By the authority aforesaid  
 and Consent aforesayd that no person whatsoever shall trade or  
 Commerce in any way deal with any servant whether hired or  
 (Indentd)
