

Summons the said Commissioners shall and may proceed as if the
said party had been actually summoned unless the said person or others
so absent upon a new summons after his or their return or being
found shall sooner appear.

And be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid
if the Surveyor of the County aforesaid shall willfully forbear or delay to
be and appear according to the tenor of the aforesaid summons and shall
Surveyor so wilfully refusing or delaying shall forfeit for every such
offence five hundred pounds of liball to the King's majt by his heirs
and Successors for Support of Government to be recovered in any Court
of record by action of debt bill. Plaintiff or Information wherein no
Espousal protection or waiver of law to be allowed - And if any
Witness so summoned shall neglect to appear at the time and
place notified or shall when appearing refuse to give his or her
Evidence it shall be lawfull for the said Commissioners to find
attachment against him her or them to cause him to come, or Comit
such witness for such their obstinacy till they give their Evidence
as the case may require And for the better Discovery of the true
bounds of the lands in dispute the Commissioners or any three of them
as aforesaid being upon the land may cause the said lands and
also any other adjacent lands for their better information to be
surveyed and trac'd duly and impartially Considered as well
the proofs and allegations of both parties as all other circum-
stances nearest concurring with the true intent Design'd
and meaning of the original Survey shall then and there
Determine and Ascertaine the limits and bounds of the said
lands in dispute as they or the major part of them then and
here present shall adjudge most just and reasonable and by
the same lands in their presence to be now mark'd out with
such marks and bounds as to them shall be adjudged most plain
and Durable and cause three fair platts and Certificates thereof
to be made by the said Surveyor two thereof for the concluding
parties and the third to be fairly Entred in a book for that
purpose to be provided by the Commissioners at the County Clerks
of good large strong paper with a leather or parchment
over which the said books shall be Lodged with the Clerk of the
County where the lands aforesaid are kept among the
records of the same County which said bounds so described and
Entred as aforesaid shall be and remain the certain undoubted
