

Aggrieved by any such order determination and decree as aforesaid shall and may be lawfull for the person so aggrieved to make application to the Governour for the time being for a speciall Com^{rs} to be directed to three persons inhabiting within this province whereof one to be of his maj^{ties} Council or one of the Justices of the prov^{ts} Court and the other two to be well skilled in the Art of Surveying and of good Character such as the Governour shall think fitt to appoint to reviewe such Determination order and Decree whia by virtue of such Commission shall have full power and Authority to reviewe the same according to the Directions and after the manner prescribed in this act and either conform the same or otherwise to Pass such further determination order and Decree of and upon the Premises as to them shall seem most just and Equitable so always that the said review shall be made and fully completed and ended as aforesaid within three months from the time of the determination made by the first Commissioners from which said Determination and Entry of the plat and Certificate thereof as aforesaid shall be no further review or appeal whatsoever allowed to any of the Courts of this province But in Case the Pretensions of any Party aggrieved shall amount unto or be adjudged to exceed the value of three hundred pounds Sterling that then and in all such Cases such party may have an appeal from such sentence of the Commissioners of review to the Kings majesty in Council he giving security to prosecute such appeals with effect or otherwise pay and satisfy all such Costs and damage as shall or may accrue to the other party for whom such sentence has been given by making such his appeals as aforesaid Provided nevertheless and it is hereby enacted and declared that the Party for whom such sentence as aforesaid shall be given shall not any ways be delayed by such appeals to the Kings Majesty as aforesaid but immediately put in Possession of the Land within the Bounds so ascertained as aforesaid and also Provided that where any Bound of Lands have been already Selled and determined by any Law Suits Arbitrations or otherwise such Determination appearing on record the same so Selled and determined shall remain and continue unalterable and no ways subject to any view or review of the Com^{rs} appointed by this Law and that it shall and may be lawfull for the provinciale Court of this province to hear and determine all actions of trespass and Ejectments already depending before them or which shall be commenced before the first day of June one thousand seven hundred and sixteen anything in this act to the contrary in anywise notwithstanding And further that this act nor any Cause therein contained shall be of force or put in Execution within any the County of this province untille the first day of June in the year of our Lord God Seventeen hundred and sixteen or Continuance (force)
