

shall be endorsed at whose request it was sued and for want of being
 endorsement the writt shall abate and the party sued shall recover
 his Costs against the attorney that sued for the said writt —

And be it enacted by the authority aforesaid by and with the
 advice and Consent aforesaid that whensoever the Grand Jury in their
 respective County Courts of this province shall make a Presentment
 of the breach of any the Laws of this province save only the Act for
 speedy tryall of Criminalls and ascertaining their Punishment
 in the County Courts when prosecuted there if the Party or Party's present-
 ed Confess his or their Crime and Submit the Court then the Clerk
 of Judgments shall have one hundred pounds of tobacco for his
 fee and no more but if the Clerk of Judgments draw a bill of
 Judgment upon the said presentment and the Party therein presented
 traverses such presentment or bill of Judgment and puts himself
 upon the Country for tryall thereof then the Clerk of the said Court
 shall have two hundred pounds of tobacco for his fee and no
 more —

And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid
 and Consent aforesaid that from and after the End of this present session
 of Assembly there shall be paid to any attorney or other person
 practising the law in any of the County Courts of this province
 for bringing prosecuting or defending any action of what nature
 or quality soever to finale Judgment agreement or other End
 thereof the sum of one hundred pounds of tobacco unless the
 principale debt and damage or balance of any debt and
 damages sued for and recovered do exceed the sum of two thousand
 pounds of tobacco or ten pounds Sterling that then the said attorney
 shall have two hundred pounds of tobacco and no more, and to
 any attorney or other person practising the Law in the Province
 Court high Court of Chancery Commissioners Court, Court of
 Vice Admiralty or for prosecuting or defending any appeal
 writts of Error or any other matter or thing whatsoever
 before his Excellency the Governour and Council the severall
 Sums hereafter Express and set down (that is to say) for prosecuting
 or defending any cause plaint or action of what nature soever
 in the Province Court to finale Judgment agreement or other
 End thereof the sum of four hundred pounds of tobacco and
 no more for any fee in the high Court of Chancery and —
