 Provided always that no Magistrate shall allow or give a certificate
 for any head or scalp of any Crow or Squirrell that shall after the
 end of this Session be killed or Destroyed by any Indian or Indians
 altho they were actually killed within y^e County where such Magistrate

 for killing Wolves Crows and Squirrells continue and no longer

An Act for transferring the payment of all
 sub fines and Forfeitures as shall hereafter arise
 or happen upon the breach of any the perall Laws
 of this province to the right honourable the Lord
 Proprieter.

Whereas his most Gracious Majesty King George has been pleased
 to restore to the right Honourable the Lord proprietor of this province the
 Government thereof whereby all the fines penalties and forfeitures that
 shall hereafter happen and are by the severall Acts of Assembly of this province
 now in force made payable to our Sovereign Lord the King his heirs or Successors
 ought to be made payable to the right honourable the Lord proprietor of
 this province AND whereas the said Laws have all safely been reenacted &
 revised with great care and at the vast expence of this province and are
 found to be officious and much conducing to the peace and Welfare thereof
 to the end that all unnecessary Charge may be avoided It is humbly
 prayed that it may be enacted AND be it enacted by his Lordship y^e
 Lord proprietor by and with the advice and Consent of his Lordships Govern
 and the upper and lower houses of Assembly and by the Authority of y^e
 Same that where by any the Laws of this province any fine penalty or
 forfeiture,
