An Act repealing an Act Entituled

Be it Enacted by the Right Honorable the Lord Pro-  
prietary by and with the advice and Consent of his Lordships Governour  
and the upper and Lower Houses of Assembly and by the authority of  
the Same that an Act of Assembly of this province Made at a Session  
of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis the twenty Eighth  
day of October Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and twelve Entituled  
an Act against Striking Sundry Sorts of fish within the precincts of  
this province and every Article Matter Clause and thing therein contained  
be and is hereby utterly Repealed and made Void in all parts
