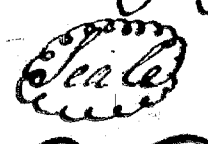


proceedings of the severall Courts of Judicature within this province
 untill this time be and are hereby confirmed so that no advantage
 shall be taken of any want of authority defect or error on such proceedings
 occasioned by such change of the government only but that all such
 defects and errors be and are hereby perfectly aided according to the true
 Intent of this Act any Law Statutes usage or Customs to the contrary
 Notwithstanding. And forasmuch as sundry the Justices of the
 Quorum in severall of the Counties of this province are members of
 the Lower house of Assembly, and whereas the severall County Courts
 of this province are appointed to be holden in the month of August so
 that either such Justices must leave the said house and service of
 their Country or that such County Courts must fall for want of their
 attendance unless provided against by a Law Be it ENACTED
 by the Authority advice and Consent ass that in case there shall not
 appear or have not appeared a sufficient number of Justices at the
 time and place appointed for the holding the County Courts regularly
 and legally according to the Tenor of their Commissions and by
 act of Assembly of this province in that case made and provided that
 then and in such case every such County Court shall be and stand
 hereby adjourned from the appointed day in August untill such day in
 November following as such Court ought to have been adjourned to any
 Law Statute or Customs to the contrary Notwithstanding.
