 and my wife and that I will acknowledge the same before the Governour  
 and that he may attest, Witness my hand and Seal this seveneenth of  
 July one thousand six hundred and eighty five Joseph Bridger Witness  
 James Bennett Robert Pilt On which said deed poll or Instrument is  
 thus Endorsed viz Memorandum that this day viz the Twenty Ninth  
 day of July Anno Domini one thousand six hundred and Ninety five  
 the within mentioned Robert Pilt made Oath before me that he saw  
 the within mentioned, Seal, Sign and Deliver the within mentioned  
 Instrument as his act and Deed John King, Clerk of the Court it like-  
 wise appears to this present Generall Assembly that the said Joseph  
 Bridger, <sup>in his lifetime</sup> being willing and desirous to performe what he by the said recited  
 deed did promise and agree to doe and Well and duly in due forme of  
 Law to assure and Convey the aforesaid Tract of Land Called Bridgers Lot  
 unto the said Thomas Jones his heirs and assigns forever according to  
 true Intent and meaning of the agreement aforesaid between them  
 the said Joseph Bridger and Hester his wife and the aforesaid Thomas  
 Jones so as aforesaid made and the true Intent and meaning of the  
 said recited Deed, well remembering that he had received of the said Thomas  
 Jones before that time the Summe of eighty pounds Sterling the pur-  
 chase money of the said Land did order and direct a deed of bargain  
 and Sale mentioned to beare date the Third day of July in that year  
 of our Lord God one thousand six hundred eighty and Six to be made &  
 prepared whereby he Designed and Intended to Convey the aforesaid  
 Tract of Land Called Bridgers Lot with the appurtenances unto the said  
 Thomas Jones his heirs and assigns forever with warranty against him the  
 said Joseph Bridger his heirs and assigns forever and all persons  
 claiming by from under him or them or any other person or persons  
 whatsoever which said tract of Land is bounded and situated in manner  
 and forme following viz Beginning at a markt white Oak stand  
 and on a point of Land Called Trading point thence with a line  
 drawn North East for breadth up the River Manokin three hundred per-  
 ches to a markt lincory standing on a high bank on the South West  
 of a creek Called Kings branch thence with a line drawn East for  
 length
