 hold plea of the said by action of Debt Bill plaint or Information wherein no Exoyne
 Protection or wagen of Law to be allowed. And be it hereby further Enacted &
 declared by the authority advice and consent of the several Collectors & Navall
 officers of this province within their severall and respective districts for the severall
 acts and things relating to their office by him or them to be and shall have and re-
 ceive the fees hereafter mentioned and no more. That is to say To the Collector for
 Entering and clearing a Ship or Vessel of one hundred tonns or more Twenty Shillings
 For Entering and clearing a Ship or Vessel under one hundred hundred Tonns ten
 Shillings for a permit two Shillings and Six pence for a Navigation bond five Shillings for
 a Certificate to Discharge a Navigation bond five Shillings for Every oath Administrated
 one Shilling for a Certificate to Export Goods out of the province five Shillings
 For transmitting and recording a Vessels Reg^y five Shillings and to the Navall
 officer for Entering and Clearing a Ship or Vessel under one hundred Tonns ten
 Shillings for Entering and Clearing a Ship above one hundred tonns twenty Shillings
 for a permit two shillings and Six pence for an Import Bond five Shillings
 for a Certificate of goods Imported five shillings for a Navigation Bond five
 Shillings for Every oath made of goods one Shilling for recording and transmit-
 ting a Ships Register five Shillings for filing and proving a Certificate and Dis-
 charging a Navigation Bond five shillings for Certificate to discharge Navigat-
 ion bond five Shillings and no more And the said collectors and Navall officers are
 hereby obliged to take but one halfe of the fees above Expressed for all Ships or
 Vessels of what Burthen soever that are either built or purchased by the India
 Company of this province, Provided the owners of the said Shippes do all actually
 reside in the same. And be it Further Enacted that all and Every
 the Collectors and Navall Officers of this province shall receive such fees as
 are set out and no more, and shall make a fair Table of their fees and put up in
 their severall Offices under the penalty of fifty pounds to be the one halfe
 thereof to the Lord proprietary for the Support of his Lordships Government
 and the other halfe to the Informer or to him or them that shall sue for the
 same to be recovered in any Court of Record within this province by action of
 Debt Bill plaint or Information wherein no Exoyne Protection or wagen of
 Law to be allowed.
