An Act for the ad-
journment of Talbot and Baltimore
County Courts

WHEREAS Sundry of the Justices of the Quorum of Talbot and
Baltimore County Courts are Members of the Lower House of Assembly
and whereas the afd County Courts are appointed by Law to be holden the
first Tuesday of June Instant so that either such Justices must Leave y^e
said house and Service of their Countrey or that such County Courts must
fall for want of their attendance unless provided against by Law.
Be it therefore Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Propri-
etary by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordships Governour &
upper and Lower Houses of Assembly and by the Authority of the same that
in case there shall not appear or have not appeared a sufficient Number
of Justices at the time and place appointed for the Holding the afd two
County Courts and to adjourne them regularly and Legally according
to the Term of their Comissions and the Act of Assembly of this Province
in that Case made and provided ^{that} then and in such Case the aforesaid
County Court of Baltimore is and stands hereby adjourned from the
appointed day in June until such a Day in August following as
such Court ought to have been adjourned to and that the said County
of Talbot be and stand hereby adjourned until the Last Tuesday in July
next any Law Statute or Customs to the contrary Notwithstanding
