Act for Building a Court house on  
 Long point on Bohemia Mannor and on the  
 East Side of a Creek called Broad Creek on Elk River  
 in Ceill County.

WHEREAS severall of the Inhabitants of Ceill County have Complaind  
 of the great Inconvenience of holding the County Court of the said County  
 at James Town on the North Side of Chesapeake in the said County and have  
 generally desired the same to be held at a Point where a certaine William  
 Thomas lives on Elk River known by the name Long point on Bohemia Mannor  
 and on the East Side of a Creek called Broad Creek being nearest the Centre of  
 said County. Be it therefore Enacted by the Right honorable the Lord pro  
 prietary and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordships Governour &  
 the Upper & Lower house of Assembly and by the Authority of the same  
 that from and after the End of this present Session of Assembly, the Justices  
 of the said County Court shall and are by Vertue of this Act Impowred  
 and required with all convenient speed to make choice of two Acres of Land on  
 Long point on Bohemia mannor and on the East Side of a Creek called Broad  
 Creek on Elk River aforesaid whereon to build or Cause to be built a new  
 Court
