

Advertisement put up at the Clerk of the County Court where such
 Advertisement shall be so put up shall make a Certificate under
 his hand and the Seal of the County and that it shall and may be
 Lawfull after such Publication and Certificate thereof had for any mini-
 ster duly Qualified to Joine together in matrimony any such persons so
 published according to the Riturgy of the church of England saveing to
 the minister of the respective parishes where such Publication shall
 be made their just dues for such Marriages And if any person shall
 presume to contract marriage without such publication and Certifi-
 cate thereof had as aforesaid or without particular Licence from the Govern-
 our for the time being do privately Contract marriage Every man so
 contracted or married shall be Liable to a fine of five thousand pounds of
 tobacco, and Every such minister Joyning in marriage any person
 without publication or Licence or any way infringing this Act shall be
 Liable to a fine of five thousand pounds of tobacco one halfe of the said Fines to
 the Lord prory his heirs and Successors for the Support of Government
 of this province the other halfe to the Informer to be recovered in any Court
 of record by action of Debt bill plaint or Information wherein no Ejoyne
 protection or wager of Law to be allowed - And for the more Effectually
 avoiding Secret and clandestine marriages - Be it Enacted by the autho-
 rity Advice and consent aforesaid that any person or persons Resident in this pro-
 vince who shall get their marriage Solemnized in any the Neighbouring
 Colonys during such their residence in this province, unless where the woman
 so married shall be resident at that place where such marriage shall be
 solemnized The man so married shall be Liable to the fine of five thousand
 pounds of tobacco to be recovered as aforesaid to the use aforesaid And for ascertaining
 to the minister aforesaid for marriages in other cases then the act for Establishment
 of religious worship provides for Be it Enacted that in Case any persons
 married by Licence and that shall be married in the parish Church or
 Chappell of Ease or come to such ministers Houss to be married there shall
 be paid as aforesaid by the persons to be married for such marriage the sum of
 ten shillings and no more and in case of publication of Names the persons
 so to be married shall come to the ministers dwelling Houss to be married
 three shall be paid to the minister as aforesaid for such marriage one hundred
 pounds of tobacco or six ^{Shillings} and eight pences Current money ready pay and
