 in the Eleventh and Twelfth year of the reign of his late Majesty King
 William the Third Chapter the fourth there is good Provisions made to
 prevent Growth of Popery as well in this Province as throughout all other
 his Majesty's Dominions, and that all Act of Assembly of this
 Province in no ways alter the Effect of that Statute, It is therefore
 Prayed that it may be Enacted And

Be it Enacted by the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord
 Proprietary by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordships Governour
 and the upper and Lower houses of Assembly and the Authority of the
 Same that the said Act of Assembly to prevent the growth of Popery
 be and is hereby repealed

A Supplementary act to the Act for the Better Administration
 of Justice in Testamentary Affairs &c.

WHEREAS the Act of Assembly of this Province Intituled
 An Act for the Administration of Justice in Probate of wills &c. it is
 amongst other things Enacted that when a full Acc^t is made up by
 any Administrat^r of any Intestates Estate the Judge therein mentioned
 shall make or Cause to be made Distribution as therein Directed, the
 making up of which Acc^t is often times Designedly Delayed and
 Estate thereby kept from the Right Owners for Remedy whereof
 Be it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary by and
 with the Advice and Consent of his Lordships Gov^r and the upper & Lower
 houses of Assembly and the Authority of the Same That it shall and
 may be lawful for any Legatee or others that have right to any Legacy
 or to the residue of any Testators or Intestates Estate after the Expiration
