

Demandts whatsoeuer in the same Matter as if tht he had never bin made any thing
therin before Contained to the Contrary Notwithstanding

And whereas Christp. Bateman of Kent County has likewise petitioned this
present Generall Assembly that he hath had vexations and Troublesome Law-
suit with a certaine Person in plaine of the same County whereby he was forced
to expend the most part of his small Substance and Estate, that the said Plaintiff
has since obtained Judgment against him and thereupon taken him in Execution
for the summe of Thirtie pounds Current money and two thousand one hundred & sixtie
One pounds of tobacco Potts Suit on which Execution he was remanded into Custody
for above these eight month past and is like to Continue so During life unless
Relied, That he is aged Sixtye yeres and severall small Children who have nothing
to support them but the said Batemans Labour and must in a short time
either become aburthen to the County or Starve for want of Food, That
he is willing to do all that is humblye towards the Complying into the Judgment
aforesaid but that all that he has in the world will not amount to thirtie pound
And that the said Plaintiff vigorously insists on keeping him in Gaol
till he has paid the culmest fasshing & this therefore the Assembly praysd that it
may be enacted and be Engaged by the Authority aforesaid by and wth
the advice and Consent aforesaid that the said Christp. Bateman upon his
Surrendering into his State upon Oath asaf^t On the condicione and under
the Penalties aforesaid payed the same summe of £ 30 to any two of the
Justices and to the Sheriff of Kent County for the use of the said Plaintiff
to have that the Sheriff haue a proportionable part of such sume to bee
surrendered towards discharge of his fees due to him on account of the

Inprisonment of the said Bateman at the rate of the said Plaintiff of £ 1 per
day, and the said Plaintiff for his said Plaintiff is hereby required to discharge the
said Bateman in relation to the said Judgment in so farre as Robert Gray
of Kent County planter has likewise petitioned this present Generall Assembly
Setting forth that he is a prisoner in Custody of the Sheriff of the same County
at the suit of John Johnson of the same County Court for a considerable sum
of mony and has continued there for the space of three months and is in no
hope of getting out alle that he has in the world not being sufficient to pay
and discharge the said Debts and Charges and where as John Budd of the
same County by his humble Petition to this present Generall Assembly
has set forth that he is likewise a Prisoner in Custody of the same Sheriff
for debt and of nobilitie hood of getting out alle that he has in the world
not being sufficient to pay and satisfy the said D. C. Ch. - wherefore
they humbly prayd relief by Article to be past in their favour for
that end Under for that the truth of the Allegacions of the said
Robert Gray and John Budd are made to appear to this present
Generall Assembly by Sufficient Testimony and therefore for that
the said Robert Gray and John Budd and their families are forthwith
