that it may be Enacted And be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid and
consent aforesaid that the said Robert Gray and John Budd upon their
Surrendering up all their Estates upon Oath as aforesaid on the Conditions
Under the penalty aforesaid enjoined the said Samuel Lyle to any two of the
Justices and to the Sheriff of Kent County for the use of the said Parties
at whose Suit they are now Detained in prison Save that the Sheriff
have a proportionable part of such Estates so to be surrendered up towards
Discharge of his fees due to him on account of the Imprisonment of the
Robert Gray and John Budd at the suit of the said Parties for which they are
now in custody It shall and may be lawful for the said Sheriff and he is hereby
required to discharge the said Robert Gray and John Budd out of his Custody
And the said parties are hereby debarred from any further Recourse or actions
ag^t the said Robert Gray and John Budd On the account for which they are
now Imprisoned
