All His Majesty Reviewing an act of a session of this Province Entituled an act for Encouragement of Tillage and relief of poor Debtors for Supplying Some Defects therein

Be it Enacted by the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietor by and with the Advice and Consent of his High Governour and the upper and lower house of Assembly and by the Authority ^{of the said} that the above mentioned act Entituled an act for Encouragement of Tillage and relief of poor Debtors made at a session of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis the twenty sixth day of April Anno Domini one thousand Seven hundred and fifteen be and is hereby Received and continued in full force from and after this present Session of Assembly for and during the term of three years and untill the End of next session of Assembly which shall first happen after the End of the said three years and no longer. And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid and Consent aforesaid that all and every person or persons who shall be described or taking the benefit of the Act aforesaid shall before the Discharge of his her or their body by vertue of that Act first the her or their Corporate Oath to be to him her or them administered

Being taken in Execution of the provisions of the said Act that he or they had not, nor had at the time of his her or their Creditor or Creditors if he or they think fit to except those of the Act aforesaid further Enacted that in case any person or persons taking the benefit of the Act aforesaid shall perjure themselves before such Justice or County Justice and be thereof convicted he or they shall incur the like penalties and penalties as persons convicted of willfull Corrupt perjury
