

Taxables in his County under his Crowne hand yearly into the Exchequer  
 Office by the twentieth day of September on pain of One thousand  
 £ of Forfeiture for every neglect to be forfeited as aforesaid to the use of the  
 recorder aforesaid. And the better to enable the Sheriff of the  
 severall Counties to returne Copys of the list of Taxables in each County  
 as aforesaid.

Be it Enacted by the Authority Advise and Consent aforesaid that  
 the severall Constables of the severall respective hundred in the  
 severall Counties are hereby required to send a Copy of their Lists of  
 Taxables to the Sheriff of their County at or before the first day of August  
 after the taking of such Lists.

And whereas it is found by Experience that there are many  
 Single Persons who are freemen in this Province who have not  
 any settled place of residence but make their Abode at such places  
 where they are employed and such Employers refuse to give them  
 in as Taxables they not being constant Residents in their Families  
 by which means they frequently escape paying any tax at all.

Be it Enacted by the Authority Advise and Consent aforesaid that it shall and may be lawfull for any  
 Constable of any hundred in any of the Counties in this Province upon  
 finding any such Single person or freeman in their respective  
 hundred who cannot procure some house keeper within such hundred  
 to give him in as Taxable nor make appear that he is employed  
 or taken as Taxable in some other hundred or County, to carry  
 such person or freeman before the next Justice of the Peace for  
 such County who is here by empowered and required to commit such  
 person or freeman into the Sheriff's Custody until he shall  
 procure some house keeper to returne him as a Taxable and be imprisoned  
 for his default.
