Made to us in our high Court of Chancery Under the Seal & the Seal  
of them by whom it was made with this Delay Send &c. 11/20/11 -  
In return of which writ in Case the person or Persons who by the said Writ  
shall be found to be the true Owner and Possessor of the Land fit to  
build a Forge mill and Other Conveniences necessary for carrying on  
an Ironwork shall refuse to build such Forge mill and Other  
Conveniences for such Iron Work thereon w<sup>th</sup> in Six Months  
from the day to be computed and Record and Give Security  
the same building to prosecute and finish within four years  
after the beginning and laying the foundation of such Forge mill  
It shall and may be lawful for his said Lordship his heirs &  
Successors Or for the Governour here for the time being from time to  
time to Grant any such One hundred Acres of Land fit to build a  
Forge mill and Conveniences for an Ironwork as aforesaid. To the  
With free Egress & Regress to the said Mill through any mans  
Land Next Adjourning by the Value of the Writ aforesaid  
returned to be paid to the Owner of the said Land so found and  
returned as aforesaid. w<sup>ch</sup> said Grant to be made as aforesaid shall  
be good and Available in Law to the Grantee or Grantee as against  
all persons what soever Any Taxe Custome or usage to the  
Contrary Notwithstanding Provided always that before any  
person or persons what soever shall have such Grant to build a Forge  
Mill and Other Conveniences for an Ironwork as aforesaid  
he or they shall Enter into Bond to his s<sup>d</sup> Lordship with two  
Sufficient Sureties in the sume of One hundred poundes  
with Condition <sup>to begin</sup> to build the said Forge mill & Conveniences  
for the Ironwork as aforesaid w<sup>th</sup> in Six months then next to come  
And the same building to prosecute & finish w<sup>th</sup> in four years
