

8. To reap any Benefit therefor the better Encouragement It is Enacted
 that all such Workmen or Labourers as shall be by such Undertakers
 Instantly Employed in the carrying on such useful Beneficial Work shall
 be exempt from the paying of Taxes for the first full year after
 their being Employed in such work as aforesaid. Provided that the Number
 of such Workmen shall be below the said number of Eighty for
 any one year. Provided nevertheless that in all such Under-
 takings shall not be made such poor waiteing or running of Ships till
 for transportation to any seven years next after their being seized of
 such Land in manner as that when it shall and may be lawful for the
 Owner or Person that where Disposed of such Land by virtue of such
 Writ to reenter upon and be reinstated in the same to all intents
 and Purposes as if such Writ had never been Obtained without being
 Obligated to returne any part of the Purchase Money for the
 same.

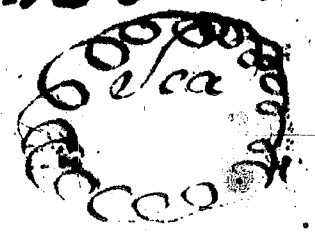
