Declared themselves so Uneasie under that they will no longer continue
in their Stations if so Turbulant and Insolent a person be allowed
to practice before them as by a presentation hereunto more fully
Appears, All which Actions and many more some where of he has
been Convict of, and others been Acquitted from by his Management
of Tricks and Subtlety in the Law so tedious to Enumerate, are of
so haughty and daring a Nature that the Honour of of the
Government cannot be Supported nor the Magistrates be Safe and
Easy in the Execution of Justice, nor the peace of this Province preserved
unless some remedy be provided for the discouragement of him
the said Maenemara in such his Practices
And whereas the said Maenemara has appeared ^{to} two Several Indictm^{ts}
found ag^t him in the Provinciale Court and One in Ann Arundels County Court
within this Province in the Year Seventeen hundred and Eighteen, And
Whereas there was One other Indictment found ag^t him in the Provinciale
Court in the same year as by the said Several Indictments annexed
may more fully appear, ^{where he hath not appeared} All w^{ch} Indictments still depend against
him in the said Courts undetermined, Since w^{ch} he hath wth Traitor
him self and fled from Justice

It is therefore Enacted by the
Right Honourable the Lord Proprietor by and with the Advice
and Consent of his Lordships Governour and the Upper and Lower
Houses of Assembly and by the Authority of the Same, That the
said Thomas Maenemara for his Continued ill practices be
and is hereby from hence forth disabled from practicing the
Law, as Counsellor Attorney Solicitor, or Otherwise in any Court
of Judicature within this Province unless he the said Maenemara
shall make his personall Appearance to this or the next Session of
Assembly and shall then shew on a full Hearing Sufficient Cause
to the Contrary thereof any Law Statute or Usage or Custom
to the Contrary Not wth Standing Savellly to the said Maenemara
a liberty to finish all such Actions as are now depending wherein
it appears by record he is actually concerned for any person or
persons on behoving himself Except in the Chancery Court
