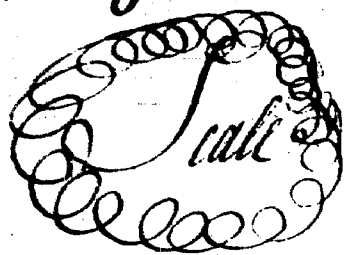

Lord Proprietary of this Province that now is upon their Oaths
do present that Thos. Maenemara late of the City of Annapolis
in Annapolis County Esq. otherwise called Thomas Maenemara
of the City aforesaid: Came the thirtieth Day of July in the second
year of the Domⁿ of the said Right Honourable Charles
Lord Baron of Baltimore absolute Lord and Proprietary of this
province and in the year of our Lord God One thousand seven hundred
and seven at the City of Annapolis in Annapolis County
well knowing his Majesty Willm^r King to be duly authorized
and Commissioned by his Lordship the Lord Proprietary
and his Noble Guardian Francis Lord Guilford by their
Commission duly published and recorded within this province to be
the Lord Proprietary Cap^t General Gov^r Governour in and over
the said province and that such by his Majesty's sacred Majesty
our now Sovereign Lord King George to be approved and
and likewise well knowing his Majesty's Majesty's Majesty
By such the said Lord Proprietary duly authorized
