

And Recorded in the Secretarys Office of this Province to be appointed
 Keeper of the said Lords proprietors Great Seal used in this province
 but being of a presumptive and turbulent Disposition and intending to
 detain and prevent his said Excellency John Hart Esq: Governour
 and Keeper of the Great Seal aforesaid from the Lawfull Execution
 of his Office of Keeper of the Great Seal aforesaid and from using
 the same at the said Lords Proprietors Court House commonly called
 the State House w^{ch} in the City of Annapolis in Annapurnde County
 then and there having discourse with a certaine Michaell Howard
 of the same City and County Esq: and the said Michaell Howard then there
 telling the s^r: Thomas Maunemara that he had Got a Supersedeas
 to his Replewin (meaning a writ of Replewin about that time sued
 out of the Court of Chancery by the afores^d: Tho: Maunemara for
 a certain Andreo Dalrymple of Somerset County Merchant to
 replevy One Schoone Called the Nightingalle, fifteen hoggs heads
 of tobacco and two Casques of Rum &c by the said Dalrymple to be
 taken from him by W^m: Bloughton Esq: against Sureties Andstidge
 &c: The said Thomas Maunemara well knowing that this writ
 of Supersedeas only Grantable by his Excellency John Hart
 Esq: Governour afores^d: as Keeper of the said Great Seal then and there
 in the hearing of the said Michaell Howard Esq: and Divers others
 leige Subjects of our Sovereign Lord King George that now is did say
 and utter the following words in a breathning Manner and went to wit
 I himself the said Thomas Maunemara (meaning) wish I could see him
 (the person meaning) that dare Grant such a writ (the aforesaid writ
 of Supersedeas Granted the Governour as Keeper of the Great Seal
 meaning) and further the Jurors afores^d: upon their Oath do say that
 Afterwards to wit on the thirteenth Day of August in the year
 the aforesaid Thomas Maunemara being a Magistrate, Alderman
 of the afores^d: City of Annapolis but of a Tumultuous brabbling
 wicked and seditious Spirit the Cordiate Respect Due
 Obediance which to the person of his said Excellency John Hart Esq:
 he then and yet Lieutenant Governour of this province and the
 Government thereof by Royall Authority Established and appointed
 to have and bear he Ought withdrawing and the Authority to his
 Excellency John Hart Esq: Governour as afores^d: Granting
 and by their said Lordships Commission then still on record
 and Duly published within this province Containing And
 setting at naught and the Good Rule and Administration
 of the Government of his said Excellency John Hart Esq: in
 And Over
