

One hundred acres, Under two hundred acres for the first hundred as before and half a pound of tobacco for the rest of acre, if be two hundred and five hundred acres, then for the first two hundred as before, and a quarter of a pound of tobacco for all above for five hundred acres as before and for all above ten pounds of tobacco of hundred acres, Every plat bearing three plats for Every Survey (that is to say) One to the party One to the Examiner Generall and the Other to be entered upon the Surveyors book ten pounds of tobacco for the first hundred acres or under and after the rate of five pounds of tobacco per cent, for all above the first hundred acres, For Journey fees if the same be distant from the Surveyors house twenty miles or under, forty pounds of tobacco, if above twenty miles under forty, eighty pounds of tobacco if above forty miles and under sixty then One hundred and twenty pounds of tobacco and so per rate, for Every full parts of Survey to the Quantity more or less five pounds of tobacco, and no more, Except it be otherwise Limited by the Act for ascertaining bounds of Lands —

Sherriffs Fees
 for Serving writs and Bayle Bond thirty five pounds of tobacco, for tending on a prisoner One day twenty four ^{shillings} and so per rate for the first month and for every day after the first month ten pounds of tobacco per day and no more, for collecting the publick the publick dues for every hundred ten pounds of tobacco for Serving an attachment or execution ten pounds of tobacco, and if any execution be for above an hundred and under five hundred pounds of tobacco fifty pounds, if it exceed fifty five hundred pounds of tobacco then One hundred pounds of tobacco, if it exceed One thousand then for the first thousand One hundred pounds of tobacco, and every thousand afterwards fifty pounds, for commitment and releasment, forty pounds of tobacco and after the same for Money or tobacco —

 the Sheriffs Sherriffs shall have no more Fees then for what shall appear to be justly Due upon such Execution and the same fees for copying any attachments for any sume what soever money or tobacco on the full value thereof in any Goods or Merchandizes provided the same be condemned to the use of the party plaintiff attaching the same and per rate for such parts thereof as shall be condemned, and if no part shall be condemned that shall be attached that then the said Sherriff shall have One hundred pounds of tobacco for returning the writ as aforesaid and no more for signifying a writ — One hundred and twenty pounds of tobacco for Serving any ~~Writ~~ Extraordinary Warrant or Commission, to be regulated by the Court, for Serving a Writ facias including the persons Summoned thirty pounds of tobacco for Serving a Statute, thirty pounds of tobacco, for executing a Commission
