And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid  
 by and with the Advice and Consent aforesaid that the Several  
 Trade Officers their Sufficient Deputies or Deputies belonging  
 to the Severall and respective Districts adjoining to the City of  
 Lincolne and to the Town and port of Oxforde shall constantly  
 reside to the said City and port for giving dispatch to all Ships  
 or Vessels trading and coming in to the said City and port  
 And it is hereby further enacted and declared by the  
 Authority advice and consent aforesaid that the Severall and  
 respective Trade Officers of this province within their Severall
