And the said Thomas Enalls since the taking up of the said Coll has built a house on part thereof and some part of the said Coll the said Enalls has given to the Inhabitants of the County aforesaid to build a Court house on one side there is a Court house now built so that the said John Clements is now wholly deprived of his Just right to the said Coll & for his relief in the premises the said John Clements has petitioned this General Assembly, and for that the truth of the premises is sufficiently made appear, and that the said John Clements Case most properly requires an equitable relief by an Act to be past in his favour the Orig. Records of the said Town all the first Copying but thereof in the Year sixteen hundred Eighty four being not to be found in which Records the said John Clements right remains, It is therefore humbly prayed that it may be Enacted

And Be it Enacted by the W. Honble the Lord Proprietor by and with the advice & Consent of his Lordships Govern. & the upper and lower houses of Assembly & by the Authority of the Same, that the said John Clements shall have hold and enjoy an Estate in fee simple to him his heirs & Assignes for ever in the said Coll of Ground anything in the aforesaid Act of Assembly made in the Year seventeen hundred & Six the taking up the said Coll by the said Enalls or the Improvement thereon made as aforesaid, or any other Law Statute usage or Custom to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding Saving to the said Lord Proprietor his heirs and Successors and all Bodies politick & Corporate and all others not mentioned in this Act their severall and respective rights

An Act Reviving and Continuing the Act intituled An Act for ascertaining the Gauge & Tare of Tobacco hogsheads &c. from the twenty ninth Day of September next untill the twenty ninth day of September which shall be in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and twenty one

Forasmuch as an Act made at a Sessions of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis in Any Arundell County the seventeenth day of July in the first Year of the Dominion of the W. Honourable Charles Absolute Lord and proprietor of the Provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore Esq. Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and Sixteen intituled An Act ascertaining the Gauge and Tare of Tobacco hogsheads, and to prevent Cropping, Cutting, and defacing Tobacco laden on Board Ships or other Vessels upon freight, and for laying Impositions on Tobacco of the hogshead for the Support of Government, and for the encouraging Settlements in this Province by ascertaining the Manner of paying his Lordships Alienation fines, and Quit Rents for the term therein proposed, and for taking of the three pence of hogshead, formerly raised for the publick Charge, Expired the twenty ninth day of September next, and to prevent any inconvenience, that
