

Commissioners or any of them that shall neglect or refuse to discharge the trust in them reposed except in case of sickness or some very pressing occasion to be adjudged by the Major part of the Commission shall forfeit five hundred pounds of Tob: to the use of the free schools in the severall Counties and that every one of the said Commissioners shall be allowed eighty pounds of Tob: for every days attend: in putting this or the said recited act in Execution in the publick way

And be it further Enacted that the severall Officers shall be obliged to give Security in the same sums and same manner as prescribed by the said recited act for such books as the said Commissioners or any three of them shall adjudg to be now in good repair and that there be a Law in the said: of every bond to make the Officers answerable for every book that shall be put into good repair by the Direction of the Commissioners and Deliver into the proper Office to which it belongs

And be it further Enacted that the said Commissioners or any three of them shall and may by vertue of this act agree w: any person that will undertake to transcribe and repair the publick Records for Money or Tob: at their Discretion anything in the said recited act to the contrary Notwithstanding
