An Act for Limitation of Actions of Trespass and Ejectment

Whereas it is Doubtful whether Actions of Trespass and Ejectment are intended
 to be limited by the Statute of the Twenty first of the said James the first intituled
 an Act for Limitation of Actions and for avoiding of Suits at Law, and for that
 these Sorts of Actions are mostly used instead of the Real Actions therein mentioned
 Be it therefore Enacted and Declared by the Rt Honble the Lord Proprietor
 by and with the Advice and Consent of his Majesty's Governour and the Upper
 and Lower houses of assembly and the Authority of the same, that all Actions
 of Trespass and Ejectment for the recovering the possession of any Tenement
 any Lands or Tenements be and are hereby Declared to be void in the future
 and under the like Limitation Rules and provisions as by the said Statute is Directed
 in the other Real Actions therein mentioned Provided always that such
