

already applied to the payment of his Debts so that nothing remains
whereby the said Mr: Custer may be indemnified and that by the Laws of this
Province the bond Entered into by the said Bozman is not assignable to the said
Mr: Custer nor the heir at Law of the said Bozman liable thereon - at this
