Be it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietor by and with the
 Advice and Consent of his Lordships Governour and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly And the Authority
 of the same That an Act made at a Session of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis the
 Eleventh Day of October Anno Domini duobus milibus quingentis et viginti Entituled an Act for raising
 a Duty of three Pence per Hogshead on all Tobaccos Exported out of this Province for the
 Uses therein mentioned be and is hereby Revised and Continued to be and remain in full Force
 from the Twentieth Day of September Instant until the Twentieth Day of September that
 shall happen in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Twenty Six -
