An Act Reviving and Continuing the Act for Ascertaining the Gauge and Tax of Tobacco Hogsheads &c.

Be it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietor by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governour and the Upper and Lower houses of Assembly and the Authority of the same that the above mentioned Act Intituled an Act Ascertaining the Gauge and Tax of Tobacco Hogsheads and to prevent Copping Cutting and Defacing Tobacco taken on board ships or vessels upon Freight and for laying Imposts on Tobacco for the Hogshead for the Support of Government and for the Encouraging Settlements in this Province by Ascertaining the Manner of buying his Lordship's Alienation fines and Quit Rents for the Term therein proposed and for taking off the same from the Hogshead formerly raised for the Public Charge made at a Session of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis the Twentieth Day of May Anno Domini One Thousand seven hundred and seven and is hereby revived and continued to be and remain in full force from the Twentieth Day of September Instant until the Twentieth Day of September which shall happen in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand seven hundred and twenty six
