An Act to Punish Blasphemy or Swearing Drunkenness and
Sabbath Breaches And for repealing the Laws heretofore made for the
Punishing Such Offences

Examined.

Be it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietor by and with the Advice and
Consent of his Lordship's Governor and the Upper and Lower houses of Assembly and the Re-
-sponsibility of the same That if any person shall hereafter within this Province wilfully Mal-
-iciously and advisedly by Writing or Speaking Blaspheme or Curse God or Deny Our Saviour
Jesus Christ to be the Son of God or shall deny the holy Trinity the Father Son and holy -
Ghost or the Godhead of any of the three persons or the Unity of the Godhead or shall utter
any profane words Concerning the holy Trinity or any the persons thereof and shall be therof
Convict by Verdict or Confession shall for his first Offence be bound through the Tongue -
and hand Twenty Pounds Sterling to the Lord Proprietor to be applied to the use of the
County where the Offence shall be committed to be levied on the Offender's Body goods or chattels
Lands or Tenements held in Possession and if he said fine cannot be levied the Offender shall suffer six Months
Imprisonment without Bail or Mainprise And that for the Second Offence the Offender being therof Convict
as aforesaid shall be stigmatized by branding in the forehead with the letter B And shall be fined forty pounds
Sterling to the Lord Proprietor to be levied as aforesaid And in case the same cannot be levied the
Offender shall suffer twelve Months Imprisonment without Bail or Mainprise And that for the third
Offence the Offender being convicted as aforesaid shall suffer Death without Benefit of the Clergy —

And be it Enacted that every person that shall hereafter profanely Swear or Curse in the
presence and hearing of any Magistrate Minister the Company Generale Surveyor Sheriff Coronor
provincial or County Clerk Deputy Mayor Church Warden or Constable or be convicted thereof before any
Magistrate by the Oath of Due Lawfull Notch or Confession of the Party shall for the first
Bait or Curse be fined two shillings and six pence Current Money and for every Oath or Curse after
and the first fine shillings like money to be applied to the uses aforesaid —

And Be it Enacted that every person that shall be Drunk in the presence of
any the Persons aforesaid or shall be therof Convict in Manner aforesaid shall be fined for
every Offence two shillings Current Money to be applied as aforesaid —

And Be it Enacted that where the said Fines shall not be immediately paid on Con-
-viction that it shall and may be lawfull for the Magistrates or other Officers aforesaid and they
are hereby required to order the Offender (not being a Proholder or other reputable person) to be
whipped or put in the Stocks And for that Purpose to appoint any person not having a lawfull
Apposition as a Constable on such Occasion to punish such Offender and that any such person to
be so appointed that shall refuse to obey such Magistrate or other Officer shall forfeit ten
shillings Current Money to be applied as aforesaid for which fine the Magistrate or other
Officer shall and may give Judgment and Reward Execution against such Offender and that where the
Offenders shall be Proholders or other reputable persons and shall not have money to pay the afore-
said fines the Magistrate or other Officer shall be and are by this Act required to Certifie all such
Convictions to the several County Clerks where the Offence shall be committed who shall every November
and make out Bills thereof with the County Survey to the several Sheriffs under the County Seal By
order whereof the Sheriffs shall and may pay the same in Money or Tobacco at One penny for pound by way
of Execution as other Publick Dues are levied — Provided always that no Offender shall receive
above Thirty Nine Shillings or be kept in the Stocks above three hours upon any one Conviction —

And be it Enacted that every Magistrate or other Officer appointed to put this
Act in Execution and being guilty themselves of Cursing Swearing or Drunkenness or Omitting to Punish
Others according to Law shall for every such Offence or Ommission and Conviction thereof in Manner aforesaid
before any other Magistrate or Officer aforesigned forfeit ten shillings Current Money to be —
