

An Act Declaring the Manner of the recovery of Fines for not appearing at
the Clearing of the Highways -

Examined,

Whereas by an Act of Assembly made at the Town and Port of Annapolis the fifth Day of September
Anno Domini Seven hundred and four Intituled an Act for Marking the high ways & there is a
fine of hundred pounds of Tobacco to be levied upon all Capable male persons that shall neglect to attend
at the Clearing and Mending the high ways when duly warned by the Overseers thereof the which fine
have proved a greater burthen to the People than was designed by that Act by means of the Clerks
way of recovering thereof in the County Courts for ready whereof BC it enacted by the Right Honourable
the Lord Proprietor by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordships Government and the
upper and lower houses of Assembly and the Authority of the same that from and after the End of
this present Session of Assembly next ensuing within this Province shall by Virtue of the aforesaid
Act be prosecuted in any County Court for their Not appearing when warned to clear
the high ways any thing contained therein to the contrary notwithstanding but in all such
cases Any One Justice of the County Courts to whom Complaint shall be made are hereby fully
authorized and impowered upon Complaint made to him against any person for not appearing
or Oweing his Servants for not holding their Servants on the high ways when duly warned
to file his Warrant to the Constable to bring such persons or Owners of Servants before
him and to summone witness as need shall require and upon Appearance before him fully
to hear and Delamine all such cases and as he shall see just and reasonable pass either to
requit & Discharge such persons or fine them according to the Direction of the aforesaid
Act of Assembly to the most therein mentioned and to be levied in manner as hereby is Directed
and every Justice of the Peace awarding such fines against any person as aforesaid are hereby
required to keep a fair Account of all such fines and to return a true List thereof to the
Justices of the County Courts yearly at the time of laying the County Assessments of which Account
the Said County Courts shall cause their Clerks to give a fair copy to the Sheriff of the County in
order to collect such fines and for Settlement and on refusal of payment thereof the Sheriff is hereby
empowered to levy the same by Way of Execution in the same Manner as the publick &
County Assessments of this Province have usually been levied and collected and render an Account
