

their Power for the liberal and Broad Education of the youth of this Province and Improving  
 their Natural Abilities and Acuteness (which seems not to be inferior to any) so as to be fitted for the  
 Discharge of their Duties in the several Stations and Employments they may be called to and Employed  
 in either in regard to Church or State and for that End laid an Imposition on sundry Commodities  
 - led out of and others Imported into this Province and other Parts for the raising a fund for the better  
 and supporting a good School in each County within this Province which has succeeded with such  
 effect that it is now thought necessary and is Craved that it may be enacted and be it enacted by  
 the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietor by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor  
 and the Upper and lower houses of Assembly and the Authority of the Town that in some convenient  
 time after the end of this present Session of Assembly there shall for the Ends before mentioned be built  
 One School in each County within this Province at the most convenient place as near the Centre of the  
 County as may be and as may be most convenient for the boarding of Children at the Discretion of  
 the Visitors (or the Major part of them) that are hereafter Nominated Appointed and Impowered by this  
 Act in each County and be it therefore enacted by the Authority aforesaid that for  
 the time being the seven several persons hereafter named for each County be and are hereby Nominated  
 Appointed and Impowered with full and sufficient Authority for Discharging the  
 several Offices Duties and Trusts referred in and required of them by this Act within the several  
 respective Counties where they reside that is to say for Saint Marys County the Reverend Sir Mayor
