Issue and give this Act or the Complification thereof with the Special Matter arising thereon to
Evidence and that in case the plaintiff or Plaintiff commanding and bringing such Action or Actions
as aforesaid shall be nonsuit the Defendant or Defendants shall recover against him or them
Double Costs of Suit Any Law Statute Usage or Custom to the County notwithstanding And be
it further enacted by the Authority Hitherto and heretofore afforded that the Sheriff of the several
and respective Counties aforesaid And every of them shall before such Execution and Delivery by as
aforesaid give publick Notice at the Chancery Court houses and Mills within the said Counties of
some certain Time by them the said Sheriff and the said two Justices to be appointed for the Dis-
tribution of the Effects of the said Thomas Senior Christopher Bohross Thomas Cobb John Gould Thomas
Boggs John Farrel John Clements John Hauler John Boldon and Joseph Gough not less than
twentynine Days after the time of the making of the said Judgment And shall then and there in the pre-
sence of two Justices as aforesaid as by their Advice and Directions make Distribution of the Es-
tate or Estates of the said Thomas Senior Christopher Bohross Thomas Cobb John Gould Thomas
Boggs John Farrel John Clements John Hauler John Boldon and Joseph Gough or of the Estate
or Estates of any or either of them so as aforesaid to be numbered Delivered up or handed be-
tween them and their Creditors Only as shall then by themselves or their Attorney or Attorneys
think fit to be present at such Distribution by an equal and proportionable Distribution thereof to
every such creditor with respect had had in Proportion to the largeness of his or her Debts the
proceedings of the said Justices and Sheriff in that behalf to be certified to the Courts of the several
Countys aforesaid and there lodged for the perusal of any of the creditors of the several Debts aforesaid
that shall require the same And without any fee to be paid thereon for such doing there-
of saving the Right of the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors
and of all bodies politick and corporate — Provided nevertheless that in case the said
Thomas Senior Christopher Bohross Thomas Cobb John Gould Thomas Boggs John Farrel
John Clements John Hauler John Boldon and Joseph Gough or either of them shall at any time
after the making such his or their Call or Call or taking such Post aforesaid be convicted
of wilfull and corrupt Injury therupon or of a wilfull breach or Noncompliance with the
Puror of such Call or Post that then the said Thomas Senior Christopher Bohross Thomas
Cobb John Gould Thomas Boggs John Farrel John Clements John Hauler John Boldon and
Joseph Gough or such or so many of them as shall be convicted as aforesaid shall upon such
Conviction be adjudged to stand two hours in the pillory And have his or their left ear cut-
off and shall be wholly deprived of any benefit designed them or either of them
by this Law and shall be thenceforth liable to be prosecuted for any Debts or Damages
whatsoever in the same manner as if this Act had never been made Any thing therein
contained to the contrary notwithstanding — And for as much as John Clements of Dorchester
County one of the languishing Prisoners before mentioned lies now in the Gaol of Annapolis
in the custody of the Sheriff of Anne Arundel County And by that means whilst he so remains
rendered incapable of complying with the matters and things required of him by this Act
It is therefore enacted that the Sheriff of Anne Arundel County be and is hereby required
immediately to demand and deliver the body of the aforesaid John Clements into the
custody of John Brent Esq; Gentleman Sheriff of Dorchester County who is hereby impowered
and required together with Messrs John Hodson Sonderus Henry Hooper Miller Havens and
Edward British or any two of them as Commissioners to put this Act as far as it relates to the aforesaid John Clements in
execution Any thing therein to the contrary notwithstanding —
