

Remainder and Provision of the aforesaid five hundred Acres of Land and all and every of their Right Title Interest and Demand which they or any of them had or thereafter should have to the five hundred Acres of Land Situate lying and being as aforesaid Called Billingsbys Point And forasmuch as the Truth of the Premises sufficiently appears to this present General Assembly It is therefore humbly prayed that it may be Enacted And be it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietor by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordships Good Honour and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly and the Authority of the Same that the said John Jordan be and is hereby Invested with a Fee Simple Estate in the said five hundred Acres of Land with the Appurtenances Called Billingsbys Point Situate and being on Calypout River in the County of George's County aforesaid And that the said John Jordan have full Power and Authority to Convey an Estate in Fee Simple to the said James Holliday Pursuant to the Agreement aforesaid And that the Same be Effectual to Barre any the Heirs of the said George Billingsby from having or pretending to have any Estate Right Title or Interest of in or to the aforesaid Land and Premises for ever hereafter notwithstanding the said Will or any thing therein contained to the contrary And that the said Entails be entirely void as to the said aforesaid Saving to his Sacred Majesty his heirs and Successors and to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors and all Bodies Politick and Corporate and all Others not mentioned in this Act their several and respective Rights
