

Wife, John Abington and Mary his Wife, William Hutchinson, and William

Whereas Gabriel Barker and Ann his wife John Abington and Mary his wife
William Hutchinson William Bile and Elizabeth his wife by their humble petition
to his Excellency the Governor and the upper and lower houses of this present General
Assembly have set forth that William Hutchinson late of Prince George's County -
Gentleman deceased by his last will and Testament bearing date the thirteenth day of
November anno Dom 1703 downtown hundred and eight hundred several tracts and -
Barrels of land to these petitioners in manner as follows I give and advise
to my Daughter Ann Hutchinson and her heirs for ever the land Biscattaway -
forest about seven hundred acres As also the land Tang where three hundred
and fifty acres And the part of former I bought of Math Hampton about two-
hundred and twenty acres And my part of friend ship fifty acres And all that part
of Hazzard from the Main Road to Biscattaway Creek where the slow Spouse stands As -
Also thirty five acres of land called Littleworth And the land called Stiffe lying upon
Mattawoman in partnership with Thomas Addison estimate eight hundred acres the
whole my part four hundred (the which said Ann Hutchinson is since intermarried
with Gabriel Barker one of the aforesaid petitioners) I give and advise to my Daughter
