An Act for Confirming a certain Deed of Settlement made by Robert Proctor
 of certain Lands and Tenements therein mentioned to his then wife Rachell now
 called Rachell Freeborn and to give the said Rachell with other Lands in
 pursuance of one Deed of Gift or Settlement

Whereas Rachell Freeborn of the City of Annapolis Widow hath set forth by her humble
 petition to this present generall Assembly that Robert Proctor late of Annapurssall County
 deceased her former Husband by his certain Deed duly made Executed and Recorded bearing
 Date the twenty fifth Day of May Sixteen Hundred Ninety and four for the Considerations in the
 said Deed mentioned did ^{give} grant Give and Confirm unto a certain Richard Hill
 in trust and for the only use of the said Rachell her heirs and assigns forever Three Several
 tracts or parcels of Land lying in Annapurssall County the one called or known by the
 name of the Intacker Surveyed for One Hundred Acres more or less One other tract called or
 known by the name of Proctors Chance Surveyed for Thirty Acres more or less One other
 tract ~~called~~ of Land called by the name of the Mill Land Surveyed for One Hundred Acres
 more or less and also that Mill with the Lands thereunto belonging Situate lying and being
 upon the North Branch of South River and also all those Mill Races Water Courses
 and Hereditaments with their and every of their Appurtenances Situate lying and being
 on Swann River in Annapurssall Town in the County aforesaid as by the said Deed Shewed
 to this present generall Assembly and Endorsed Entered in Lib. B. fol. Five Hundred and Sixty
 Seven Tho. Briscoe (the which record Book was Burnt in the late Starthouse fire in the
 County office of said County) more fully appears But that the two County Justices before
 whom the said Deed was really acknowledged omitted to Sign their Names to the same
 acknowledgement on the said Deed Endorsed altho one of them signed the same Deed
