

(81) *Exam* *Act for the Relief of James Moore*  
*of Baltimore County*

Whereas James Moore of Baltimore County  
By his humble petition to this Assembly hath set forth  
That Thomas Roberts Late of Baltimore County Gentleman  
Deceased was Seised in fee Simple of several Tracts of  
Land and by his Last will and Testament in writing  
Duly proved Devised Lands to Every One of his  
Children in fee and gave Express Directions to the  
person Employed to write his will to Invert & Devise  
In his said will of Three hundred and fifty Acres of  
Land part of Roberts his Forrest lying in the said  
County unto Elizabeth his wife with full power  
and Authority to Dispose thereof the Better to  
Enable her to Discharge the said Deceaseds Just  
Debts and Support her self and that the said  
Elizabeth Believing the said will to have Been  
penned according to the Testators Intentions sold  
and Conveyed the said Land to One John Croft for  
Seven Thousand pounds of Tobacco wherewith she  
Discharged severall of the Deceaseds Just Debts  
and applyed the Residue to her own necessary  
Support which Land hath been sold by the said John  
Croft to the said James Moore That upon Inspecti-  
on of the said will it appears that as it is worded  
The said three hundred and fifty Acres of Land  
are Intailed On the said Elizabeth and the Heir of  
Her Body Lawfully begotten by the Ignorance or  
Misapprehension of the Writer And whereas  
The premises have been fully proved to this Assembly  
and Francis Roberts son and heir at Law of the  
said Thomas Roberts and Elizabeth his wife  
having had due notice to appear and make his
