Be it therefore Enacted by the right
Honourable the Lord Proprietary and with the advice and
Consent of his Lordship's Governour and the upper and
Lower Houses of Assembly and the authority of the same
That the said Three hundred and fifty acres of Land
part of Roberts his forest shall be demed and taken to
have been Devised to the said Elizabeth Roberts in fee
Simple and that those who have her Estate therein
shall have the same Right and Title therein as if
the Devise thereof by the said Thomas Roberts had
been Expressly in fee Simple any thing in the said will
or any Law usage or Custom to the contrary notwith-
standing save to His most sacred Majesty his heirs
and Successors his Lordship the Lord Proprietary
His heirs and Successors and to all Body's politick
and Corporate and all others not mentioned in this
Act their severall and Respective Rights
